I spent 2 months on board Just J's during their shipyard period and during the vessel's crossing back over to Miami from France. As this was my first experience both in the shipyard and doing a crossing I learned many valuable skills and was shown how boats usually operate during a crossing. My shipyard duties involved painting, varnishing and caulking during the month I was there with the boat. During the crossing I was on a 2-6 watch schedule so in the afternoon I would check in with the bridge and if traffic was quiet I would complete required duties such as Semco and varnish the deck furniture, polish all the stainless and 2-part the teak. During my watch in the morning I was eager to learn more about the bridge and the OOW's taught me all aspects from navigating with charts, how to maintain a safe lookout, keeping an accurate log of the vessel each hour and the bridge equipment. These two months onboard have given me valuable shipyard and crossing experience which I can utilize in future positions.

Sole Deck/Stew June 10th 2022 - October 1st 2022

A seasonal position working onboard as the sole deck/stew for 4 months, during my time onboard I gained essential yacht experience for both deck and steward roles. My deck duties involved general maintenance, wash downs, polishing, teak maintenance and tender driving (3.25m Williams). My duties as a steward onboard involved general housekeeping, wine and cocktail service when guests were onboard, detailing and provisioning for boss trips. This dual role onboard has helped expose me to industry and has given me a far greater understanding of the work involved on both the deck and the interior as well as how to provide an exceptional service to both the owner and guests.
