MY Sealion, 62m VSY, 7 November 2022 - Ongoing

- This day work experience is very different to any other day work I have done before. This vessel is currently undergoing a complete refit, bow to stern. It is considered to be the largest Super-yacht refit currently happening across the globe. This has allowed me to develop and learn many more skills. **Duties:** Sanding steel plates (using sanding machines, drills with wire brush attachments, chisels & sanding by hand), painting steel plates, Building dust containment room on the sundeck and in the tender garage using plastic sheets and various different tapes, protecting the boat (covering the paint and teak with chloroplast, blue diamond, elephant skin & yellow or blue tape), draining out bilges and cleaning them, cleaning and re-organising the engine room, sanding wooden wall panels, polishing stainless (Flitz dry polish & Collinite wax insulator), prepping the yacht for Hurricane Nicole, carrying heavy & awkward objects on and off the yacht. Protecting, moving & organising interior furniture, and ceiling panels, installing floor to ceiling mirrors.

MY Carinthia VII, 97m Lurssen, 22nd-25th June 2022

- This was by far the largest vessel I have worked on. The experience and the "tricks of the trade" I learnt on board MY Carinthia VII were invaluable. I learnt how to work a lot faster, yet still producing the same quality results. I also learnt a lot more about how important communicating with your fellow crew is (specifically large crews), especially within your own department. **Duties:** Wash-downs, polishing stainless (Star Clean wet polish), setting up sun awnings across aft deck, moving furniture & heavy objects, organising storage space & detailing.

MY Sea Raider V, 40m Sunseeker, 20th-21st June 2022

- I was contacted by the new Chief Officer of the vessel who I had previously met dock walking. My assistance was required to get the boat ready for the owner to come onboard. This meant the vessel had to be spotless and toys needed to be clean and ready to go. This was not just for the exterior of the vessel, I had to also assist with cleaning the engine room for the first time which was a new learning opportunity. **Duties:** Wash-down, polish stainless (Flitz dry polish), engine room clean & polish, hull wash using a raft & major detailing (adhesive remover & K2R).

SY Parsifal III, 54m Perini Navi, 9th-18th June 2022

- I joined the vessel and crew in Denia, Spain where we prepared the vessel for a passage to Sardinia, Italy. This was my first passage and first time staying on board a vessel. I joined the crew so that we could prep and deliver the boat for the

Below Deck Sailing production crew, and we assisted then to get the boat ready for the show. The crew had a great dynamic and we connected well and quickly, which led to a lot of knowledge being shared with me. **Duties:** scrubbing teak, lifting the tender in and out of the tender garage with a crane, mooring and line work, assisting with bunkering operations, setting up lines on the mast, wash-downs, polishing stainless (Flitz dry polish), cleaning and taking stock of the wash locker, detailing, fitting exterior cushion covers, fender handling and putting up sails. This voyage also gave me the opportunity to perform my first watches as well, 2 day and 2-night watches (4hours each).

MY Rahal, 47m Feadship, 5th-7th May 2022

-This was my first time working on board a super yacht. I managed to get day work onboard MY Rahal through the Chief Officer on board who I had networked with when I arrived in the SoF. During my time onboard I learnt the basics of being a deckhand. **Duties:** Wash-downs, polishing Stainless (Flitz wet polish), polishing fibreglass (Collinite), detailing, cleaning the waterline on a raft. This day work also included a one-day full guest charter (12 guests) which was an amazing learning experience.

Wally's Pub and Grill, June2021-December 2021

- After completing my yachting courses Covid-19 restrictions prevented me from getting out of South Africa to go try find a job on board a yacht. I decided to then instead of sitting around and wasting time, let me develop another skill (bartending) which could benefit me in the yachting industry, as well as earn some extra income.

Auma South Africa, October 2019-May 2021

- While completing my Honour's and master's degree at university, I was offered an internship at a German international company called Auma. Here I was a part of the internal sales division. I also assisted the accountants with capturing ledger transactions and compiling financial reports using Pastel & Sage. Lastly, I also managed and lead a marketing campaign for two new products which the company had launched.
