I started my career on Azteca which was based out of Cabo San Lucas, Mexico and did yard periods up north in San Diego, USA. I finished my career onboard as Bosun. I worked with a deck team of 4 including myself. We employed a communicative, respectful, diligent and hardworking ethos in the deck team which resulted in great cohesion of the deck department. The vessel did many charters and family trips, some of which were 3.5 months back to back. We were also fortunate enough to have extensive yard periods, the longest one being 7 months. At the end of 2020 I went home on sabbatical and furthered my OOW studies. After completing the majority of the modules I rejoined Azteca. I had a great time onboard Azteca and have learnt a substantial amount of information and am now looking to further my career and gain new experiences that the world and life has to offer.

Deck work

During my time on Azteca I had the privilege of working in very desolate locations which required a number of unique procedures and activities to ensure that our guests were able to enjoy their time. Some of these activities included Reckie missions to scout for new anchorages, deep sea fishing, scuba diving, water sports, events, numerous charters in fleets, assisted in in marine videography excursions, marling fishing, seal and whale shark diving as well as extensive beach set ups. We drove a number of tenders including jet and 4x400R Mercury outboards on a 42ft Boston Whaler 420 Outrage. We were also fortunate enough to have done lengthy and intense yard periods where I was able to gain hands on knowledge from numerous craftsman who were all professionals/ masters in their respective trades. All in all I am very grateful for the experiences I have had and look forward to taking the knowledge with and applying it as well as sharing it with fellow seafarers. Below is a non-exhaustive list of the skills I have acquired over my time onboard vachts.

Knots & line handling; Surface prep, taping, filling and fairing; Awl Grip paints, 545 & Polyurethane topcoats; Woodwork (1&2 part) varnishing; Crane operations and rescue procedures.

Tender driving, close quarter manoeuvring & beach launch; Wake boarding & skiing procedures; Yachting terminology, communication & signals; Deck duties & watch keeping; Wash downs, deck cleaning & preventative maintenance; Prep and Etiquette for guests.
